Rules Covenant

There are only two rules you will *really* need to follow for this trip. Love God, Love Others. Due to the nature of this trip we will enforce a few extra rules.

NO complaining, fighting, stealing, weapons, explosives, drugs (prescriptions are ok), alcohol, back talk to a youth sponsor, being alone with a member of the opposite sex, wandering off, disrespect of any kind, skipping showers and smelling really bad, or staying up all night and being a pain in the leaders neck all day.

Each Youth Sponsor will have authority to create and enforce special rules within reason.

We will be enforcing a No Touch Policy. This means Guys and Girls will not be allowed to touch each other. At all. For any reason. No hugs, high fives, or handshakes.
