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Camp Rules

1. All campers will remain within the camp boundaries unless accompanied by staff personnel.
2. All campers will dress modestly. Shirts and shoes must be worn outside pool area. No short shorts or other extremes of dress. **Tennis shoes are a must!**
3. No destroying of property.
4. No boys in girls' dorm or girls in boys' dorm.
5. No electronic items can be brought to camp such as radios, tape players, games, cell phones, etc.
6. No phone calls home without Camp Director's permission. Emergencies only, please.
7. Camp grounds are to be kept clean.
8. All campers bringing medicine must give it to the camp nurse upon arrival.
9. After "lights out," there shall be quiet.
10. Campers may not leave their dorm after "lights out" except for sickness or emergency. Camper must tell their counselor of such sickness or emergency.

Direction to Nazarene Campground Sprouses Corner, Virginia

Take 460 to Appomattox. Take a left on Rt. 24 still going towards Appomattox. Go through Appomattox Battlefield Park (still on Rt. 24), take a right onto Rt. 60 towards Richmond. Go through Buckingham Courthouse. The campground is about 5-6 miles after this. You will pass a high school and new middle school on your left and then you will need to turn left before the red light. If you get to a red light turn around. There is a sign that says Nazarene Campground. After you turn left, you will go about 1-2 blocks to the entrance. Upon arrival please check in at the tabernacle in the center of camp.
